brain pictures.

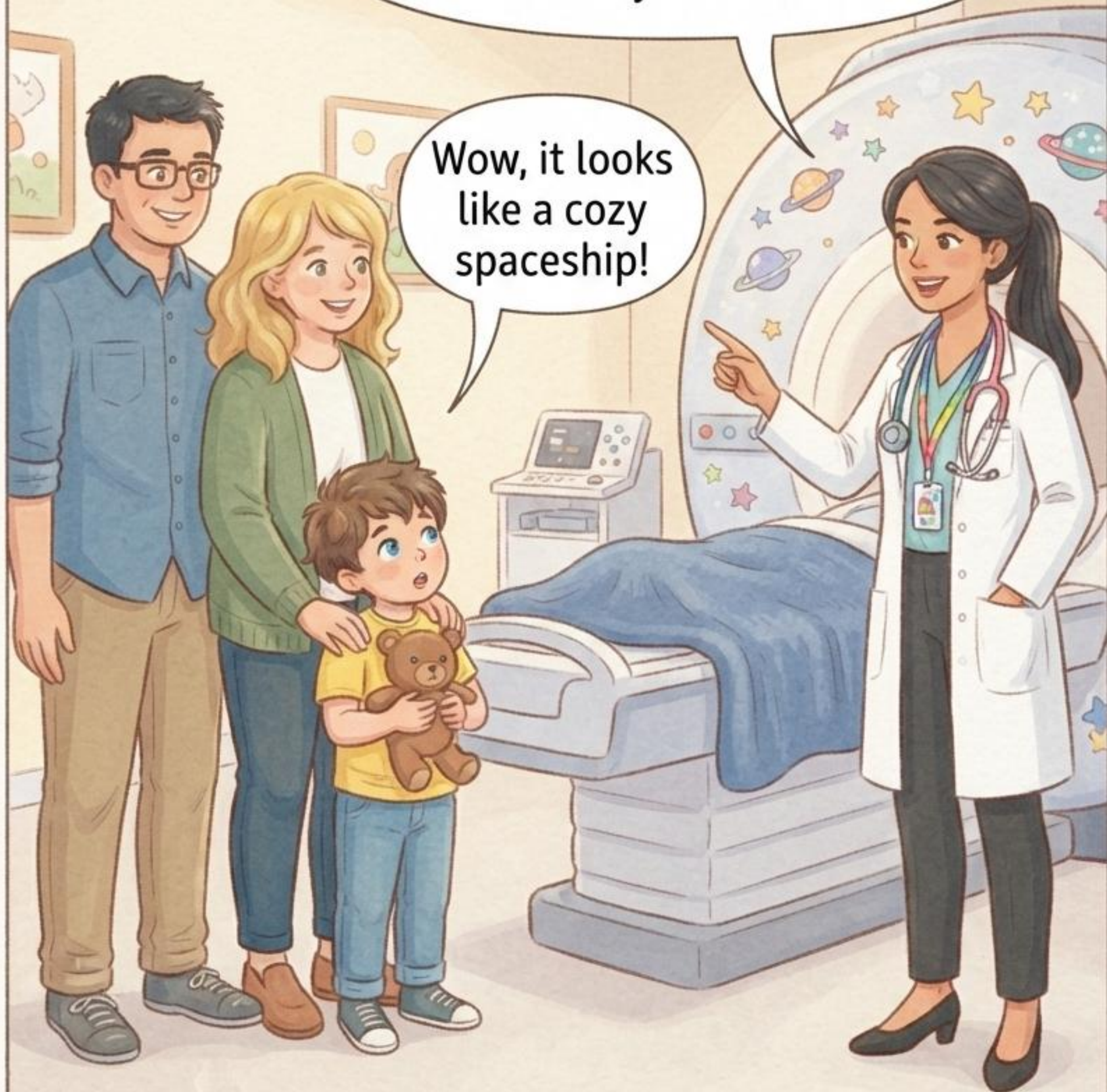
A space

Leo climbed onto the cozy bed and cuddled his teddy bear. His mom held his hand so he knew she was right there.



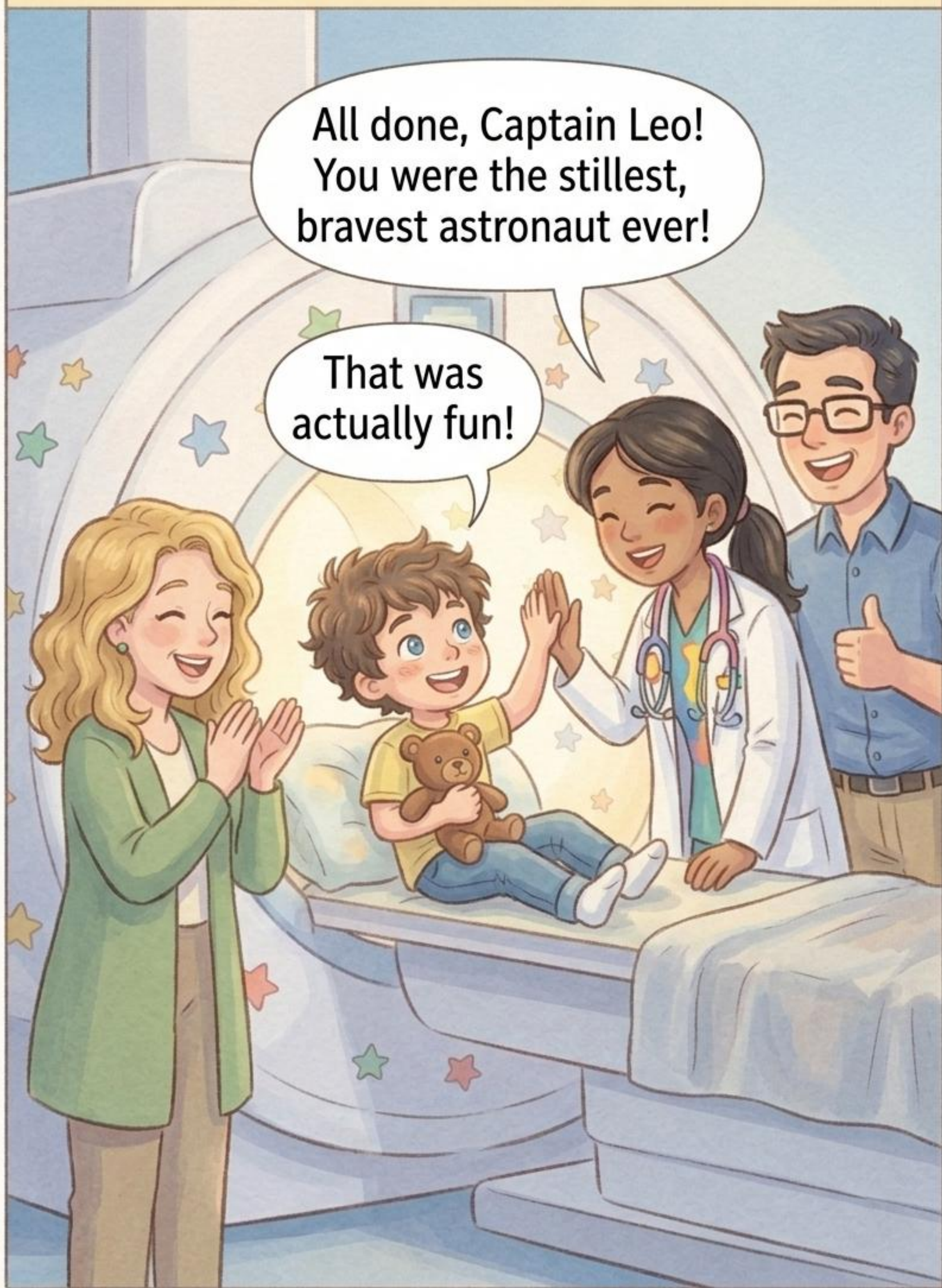
Dr. Emily said, "As the machine made funny thumping and humming noises, Leo closed his eyes and pretended he was floating peacefully in space, staying as still as a statue."

bravest astronaut ever!

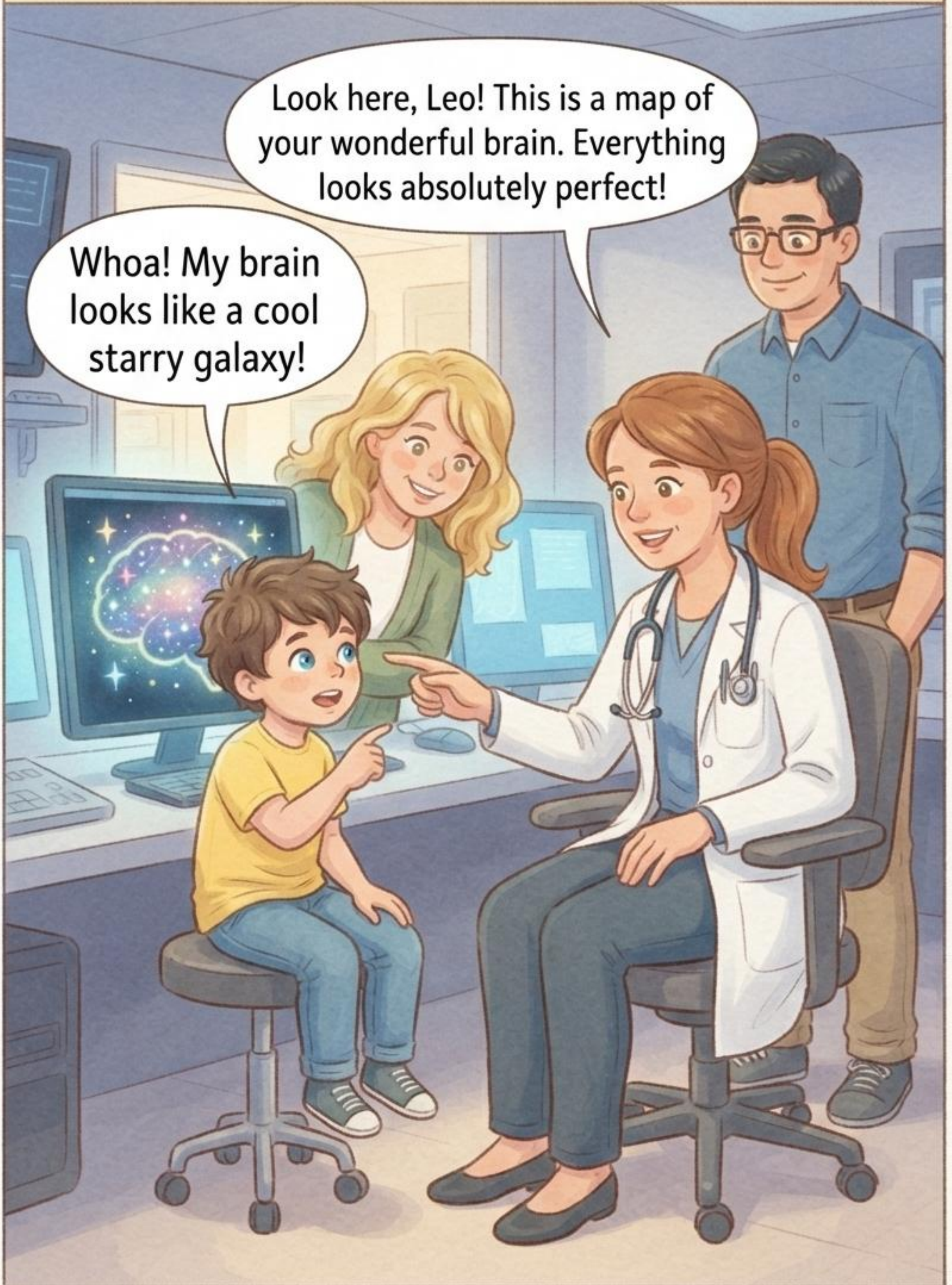
That was
